

Entangled Minds: Extrasensory Experiences In A Quantum Reality

Is everything connected? Can we sense what's happening to loved ones thousands of miles away? Why are we sometimes certain of a caller's identity the instant the phone rings? Do intuitive hunches contain information about future events? Is it possible to perceive without the use of the ordinary senses? Many people believe that such "psychic phenomena" are rare talents or divine gifts. Others don't believe they exist at all. But the latest scientific research shows that these phenomena are both real and widespread, and are an unavoidable consequence of the interconnected, entangled physical reality we live in. Albert Einstein called entanglement "spooky action at a distance" -- the way two objects remain connected through time and space, without communicating in any conventional way, long after their initial interaction has taken place. Could a similar entanglement of minds explain our apparent psychic abilities? Dean Radin, senior scientist at the Institute of Noetic Sciences, believes it might. In this illuminating book, Radin shows how we know that psychic phenomena such as telepathy, clairvoyance, and psychokinesis are real, based on scientific evidence from thousands of controlled lab tests. Radin surveys the origins of this research and explores, among many topics, the collective premonitions of 9/11. He reveals the physical reality behind our uncanny telepathic experiences and intuitive hunches, and he debunks the skeptical myths surrounding them. Entangled Minds sets the stage for a rational, scientific understanding of psychic experience.

Dean Radin, Ph.D., is Laboratory Director at the Institute of Noetic Sciences in Petaluma, California. He worked at AT&T Bell Laboratories and GTE Laboratories on advanced telecommunications systems, and for nearly two decades he has conducted research on psychic phenomena in academia (Princeton University, University of Edinburgh, University of Nevada), and in three Silicon Valley think tanks (Interval Research Corporation, Boundary Institute, and SRI International). At SRI he served as a scientist on a highly classified program investigating psi phenomena for the U.S. government. Radin is the author of The Conscious Universe, which was a #1 parapsychology bestseller at .com. It also won the 1997 Book Award from The Scientific and Medical Network, a Best Book Award from The Anomalist, and it has been translated into eight languages.

This is a paradigm changer. The understanding that our minds are entangled in a deep and complex way implies that reality is not as perceived by the ego consciousness and the materialistic mechanistic world view. Indeed we are entangled with the biosphere.Dean provides a great deal of scientific evidence for PSI phenomena and any scientist should consider the meta-data analysis as proof that something extraordinary and worthy of serious study is going on here. Dean then begins to consider the implications and some possible explanations. He remains scientific and understands that a theory of a quantum entanglement between our minds is just a way of explaining the

mysteries which are clearly shown to exist with the scientific experiments which have been conducted.

As a person who has scientific training coupled with an interest in metaphysical phenomena I virtually devoured this book. If you could see my copy with all the underlined passages and dog-eared pages you would have some idea of how much I liked it. As a science fiction author myself I was reading it primarily as research for a book I'm currently writing. I not only gained numerous insights and additional ideas related to my own work but learned how much research has been guietly done beyond the scenes in this fascinating field that studies the mysteries of human consciousness. The author's detailed accounts of experiments investigating psychic abilities were well presented and I must say I laughed out loud numerous times at his dry wit and sarcastic humor. If you have ever experienced deja-vu and wonder if it was just your imagination you will find comfort and validation in this well-documented work. While this field suffers a lot of criticism and ridicule such as found in the old movie "Ghostbusters" when Bill Murray uses a deck of cards with various symbols to convince a young, beautiful conquest of her supposed psychic ability, Dr. Radin uses statistics to demonstrate that such abilities do indeed exist by beating the odds, often by incredible proportions in the range of millions and even billions and beyond to one. There is something going on that is real and he and his colleagues are determined to find out what and how it operates. Undoubtedly the scientific answers to exactly how these phenomena fit into the "real world" lie within the realms of quantum physics. More and more scientists are exploring the mysteries of human consciousness in a way that cannot be ignored or denigrated to the realms of quacks. Indeed, many of the theories coming out of quantum theory are far weirder than psychic phenomena. The connections humans share, particularly with loved ones, cannot be denied even if they cannot as yet be explained scientifically (i.e. mathematically) yet this work shows that numerous well-trained scientists are giving it the attention it deserves. Those that dismiss it will undoubtedly be forced to eat the proverbial crow at some point and I am confident that Dr. Radin will be the one serving it up.

The whole subject is hard to talk without bit of mystical vibe, but still author manages to stay real(scientific) and encourages that way of thinking, so after reading you'll be left with some knew knowledge that has practical weight.
