I have been working with polymer clay for several month now and like with most things that I try I see it I sort of like so I jump in with an array of supplies and tools a few instructions (most of which are hard to understand) do some projects and loose interest because the instructions are just too complicated! Evi I applaud you! Anyone can use these instructions beginning for the first time intermediate or advanced and will still learn something new!

For a master class, this is too basic. A good beginners book, though... well written and photographed. Just don't expect anything other books don't also cover.

If you are trying polymer clay for the very first time this is a good book for that. The projects require very few tools, most of which you may already have. The projects are presented clearly and simply. If you have already invested in a pasta machine and taken a workshop, then this book is probably already too basic for you.

Evi's primer on polymer clay is the third I've tried, and by far the best....her very light hand and warm tone were just the thing to encourage me to get started in this medium. Perhaps it's that stream-of-consciousness style.....
