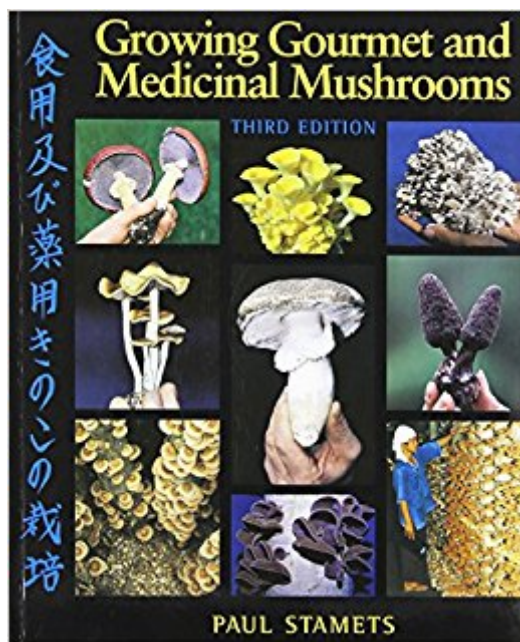

The steps are for more ambitious mushroom growers who want to know the ins and outs of cultivation through hands on work (as opposed to buying some ready made mushroom growing kit and staring at it for 2 weeks). This is written more for the commercial grower (or soon-to-be) than the home grower, however as a home grower I really enjoyed the scientific and practical explanations of each variety and how to set up a growing system that best suits each type.

Absolutely love this book! Yes, it's pretty technical but that's right up my alley. It does seem there is a bit of information missing from some of the processes. I "fill in the blanks" with information from other books. *Fungi Perfecti*, owned by Stamets, has been really good about answering questions I have about any of the processes, big or small as well as troubleshooting issues I may have. Also, yes, the book is written mainly with the large cultivator in mind, but the principles are all the same...just scale down to the size you want.
