

Originally written in 1916, shortly after the Historic Columbia River Highway was opened, it has been updated since then to include more recent geological discoveries. The reader will learn of the various types of rock formations that can be seen from the highway, and what their origins are. The Columbia River Gorge is geologically unique as it is the only place in the world where a river flows across a mountain range from one side to the other, and with this book the reader is able to understand a great deal about the geological processes that made it what we see today.
