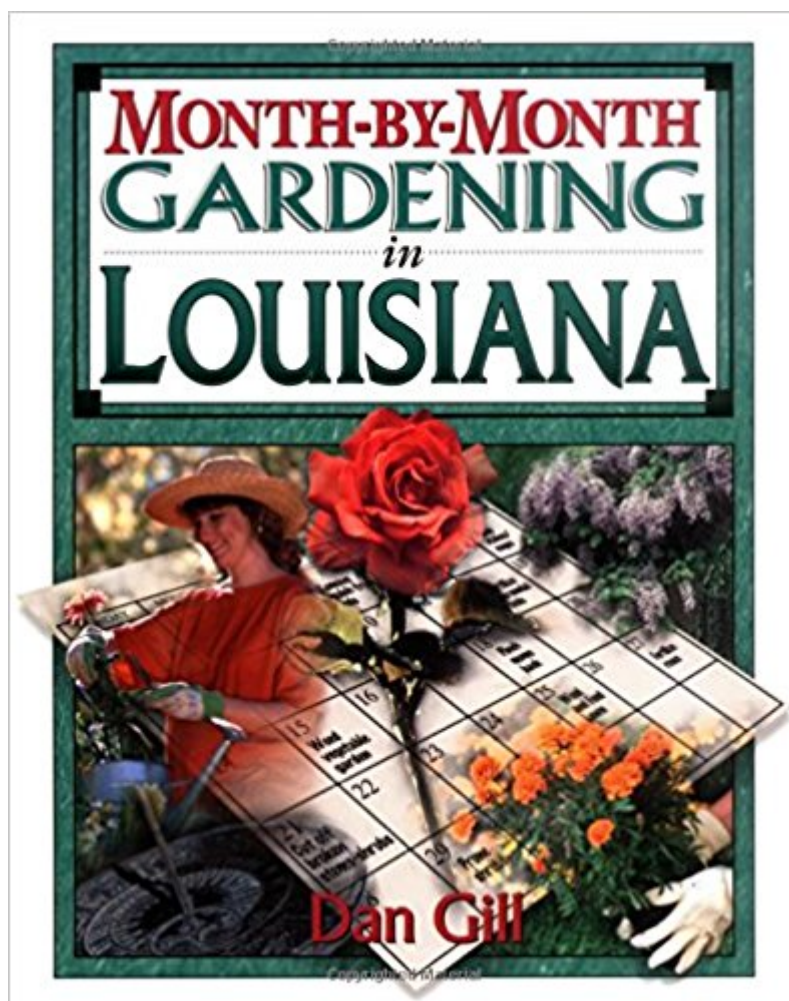

It's important that you realize when you buy this book that you will not be getting detailed plant information. However, what this book is ideal for is finding out **WHEN** to plant in your garden. Someone else mentioned that there was no information about Creole tomatoes, but what some people don't realize is that any tomato grown in Southern Louisiana soil is "Creole". Some people do sell a tomato called "Creole" however these are merely tomato seeds from tomatoes grown in Creole soil.What I was **EXTREMELY** surprised by (in the Trees section of the book) was no mention whatsoever of citrus trees. No satsumas. No navel oranges. Nothing. Now, if someone corrects me, I'm more than happy to accept it, but I can't find any information in the book.I bought this book for the Vegetables and Herbs section, but there are many other pages that provide a wealth of information on annuals, perennials, trees, shrubs...even water plants.As far as the seller goes, the shipping was much faster than I anticipated. Overall, I'm very pleased with my purchase.
