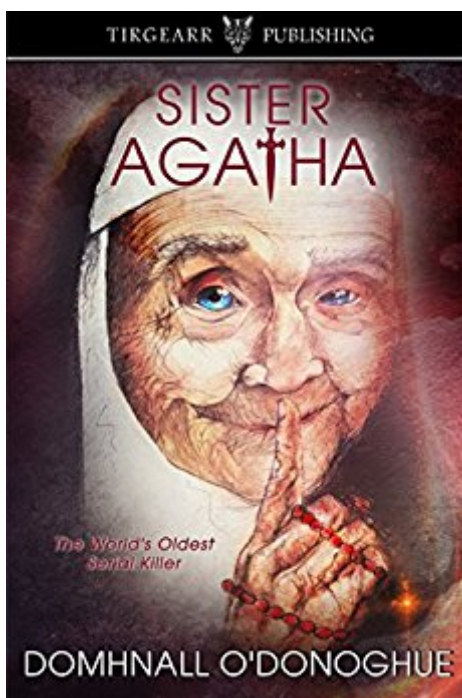

What a charming book! The beginning was good but as the stories started coming together, I began smiling and was soon chuckling aloud. I don't chuckle aloud. Usually. By the end, I was grinning from ear to ear. And my husband loved it too. I SO hope this author is planning more books in this vein. I'll be standing in line to buy them!

Sister Agatha is a book filled with character, wit and heart. It is a fast-paced page-turner, which will leave you with a grin on your face from the first page to the last. Sister Agatha herself is a fascinating figure, and as the narrative follows her and her travels, the novel unfolds with a hilarious and often moving ensemble of supporting characters. Great for armchair travelling, Sister Agatha is highly entertaining and well written- a sparkling debut from this first time novelist.

Sister Agatha might be 118, but there are four others older than she is. She wants to be the oldest person to have ever lived which means she must kill the people before she kicks the bucket. Not a believer in moderation, this Sister of Christ travels to places where the four reside: Tunis, the United State, Poland, and Italy. Remembering how she came to be, entertaining and funny flashbacks are foremost in her mind, but her observations are as keen as her wit. Never mind that in the convent the former Butsy Miller became known as the dustbin because she polished off the leftovers. If she can turn off the inner self-righteous voice, she has the stomach for murder. In Tunis does she stone Tayri Chakchouk? What about the others? I highly recommend Sister Agatha to those who enjoy comedy thrillers. Nicely written by Domhnall O'Donoghue.

This book is probably one of the funniest books I've read this year. The writer takes you from one hilarious situation to another that the traveling nun goes through in a way that will make you laugh *certain body part* off. What I liked the most was the amount of background stories that the writer gives for almost all the secondary characters that Agatha will meet through her journey; they are some of the most unique and random characters you will get to know. You will have a great time reading this book!
