

I have witnessed two U.S. military services in training. I wanted to know what made Marines so special. Nick Popaditch did a wonderful job of explaining to prospective recruits what they can expect from Marine Recruit Training and to prepare them for this ordeal. Training is not hap-hazard. It may seem very confusing to raw recruits at the time, but every sequence of events leads to just one outcome: a battle ready Marine. Nick was a drill instructor and wounded war veteran. He has the rare ability to communicate his experiences in a motivational way. Now I know why Marines are considered to be the few and the proud. So it is.
