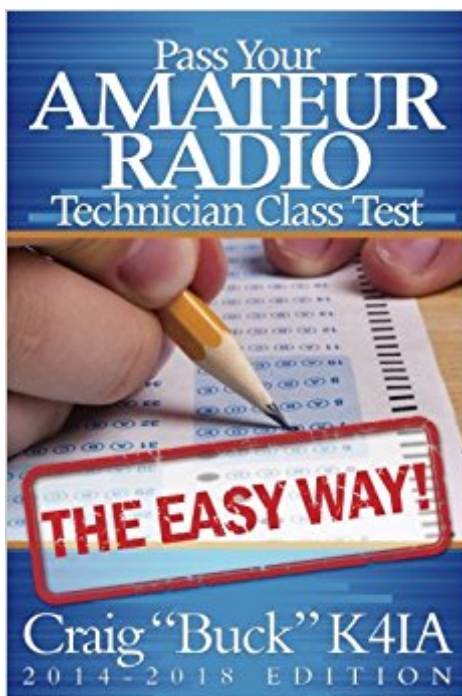

Craig Buck was first licensed as an amateur radio operator in the mid-sixties. Today, he holds an Amateur Extra Class Radio license. "Buck," as he is known on the air, is an active instructor and a Volunteer Examiner and has successfully led many students through this material. Buck's ham accomplishments include being named Elmer (Trainer) of the year by the Rappahannock Valley Amateur Radio club three times. He also holds a position on the prestigious ARRL Honor Roll for having confirmed contacts with 335 of the 339 recognized amateur radio countries.

There is no better way to learn about amateur radio and pass the FCC's Technician Certification test than with Craig Buck's book. I was unfamiliar with all the concepts, but Buck walks you through his childhood discovery of the world of radio, using personal anecdotes to illustrate fundamental concepts of radio waves and transmission, electricity, equipment, etc. His method of instruction made the previously unfathomable very easy to understand, and coupled with his time-saving method of mastering the FCC test material, I was able to understand the material, and pass the test, easily, and with a minimum of time invested.
