

It is like a small chapter in a real handbook. Covers no structure or materials, nothing about scale or a whole lot of other modeling considerations. Not very useful.

While the information is good, there is only ONE article about what a railroad truck looks like and the different names for the parts of the railroad truck. Not what I expected, I thought it would be more about scenery.

This was more like a rambling 10 page overview 6th grade essay, with no genuine focus, and no solid foundation.

This book covers just about everything in modeling on the finishing end. It also covers alot of different parts of painting and how to get different effects on a varity of types of models

Hope I didn't pay much. Indicates over 300 pages, but jumps blocks of pages in many places. Reads like nothing is omitted, but it's not 300+ pages!
