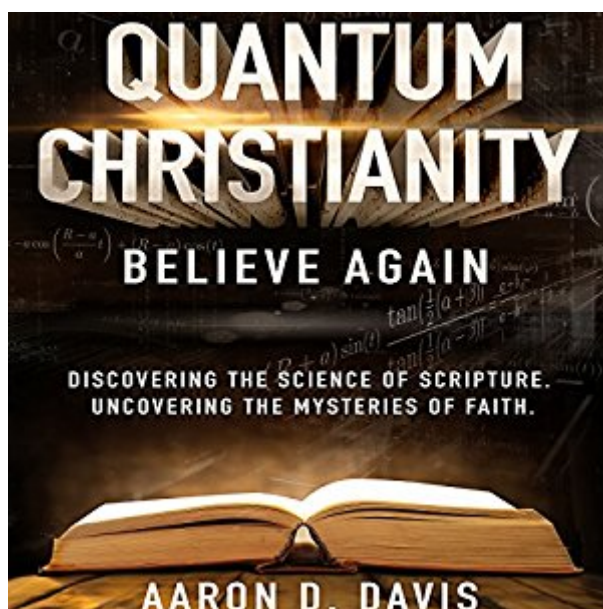

This book is a must read for this generation. Whether you call yourself a Christian or not, this book is something you need to read (or hear if you're like me and you prefer the audio version). When I heard the title I wasn't sure if it was something for me. I didn't think I had the mind to appreciate, let alone understand exactly what was going to be in this book. I was so wrong. Aaron does a beautiful job at simplifying the parts that may have otherwise been lost on someone like me, and also at weaving his personal story into the context so that I was able to see how it applied to my daily life. He captures the reader from the beginning by talking about his journey to write this book. When you read the part about how he almost lost his life as a police officer you'll understand what I'm talking about. There are so many things I could talk about that have challenged and encouraged me while reading this book, but I don't want to do the content an injustice by summarizing it without giving Aaron the opportunity to walk you through his thoughts the way he did with me in this book. Sometimes you can't understand the answers of tomorrow without thorough exploration of the questions today. As Aaron explains his thoughts the answers build upon themselves and the journey is what makes the conclusion so poignant. If you have ever been confronted with trying to answer or rationalize why God seems so contradictory in the bible verses what you see in the world around you, this book is for you. If you have completely disregarded God, the bible, and the whole Christian thing, this book is for you. If you have been a Christian for longer than you can remember and you've found yourself answering the majority of tough questions people ask you with, it's just the will of God. This book is for you. If you're a pastor, this book is for you. If you want nothing to do with God, this book is for you.
