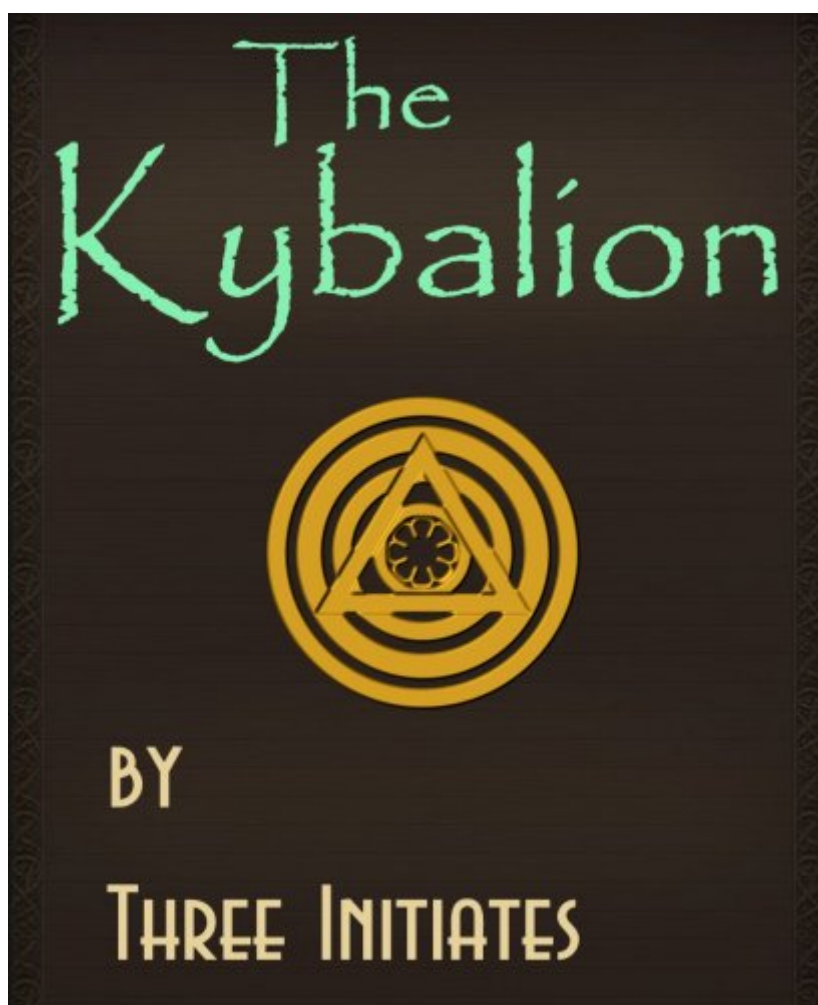

The book is short and sweet, and stands as a recognized classic for initiates delving into the occult. Like all Philosophies, the Hermetic teachings are another equally valid way to see reality. What sets the Hermetic teachings apart from others is a reduction of our experience to its utmost basic. A simplified way to describe Hermetics is that it is a study of universal vibration. All is mental. Mental phenomena is vibration. Vibration is polar. Vibration exhibits gender qualities. While the implication is that a mastery of vibration allows universal control of experience, including manipulation of perceived matter, The Kybalion focuses more on the mental aspects of vibratory manipulation. In that way, you can gain control over your own thought and emotional processes. Happiness Is a Choice, and the Hermetic practice is one way to understand how to choose.

One of the most important books I have read. I'm not too much into mysticism since many of the ideas seem groundless, but this book is well-written, logical and not far-fetched. Science is about the universe being matter. This book reveals the great, hidden truth that all matter in the universe, is actually the mind.

While this is an excellent treatise on the seven hermetic principles, the understanding given is sometimes still a bit lacking.
