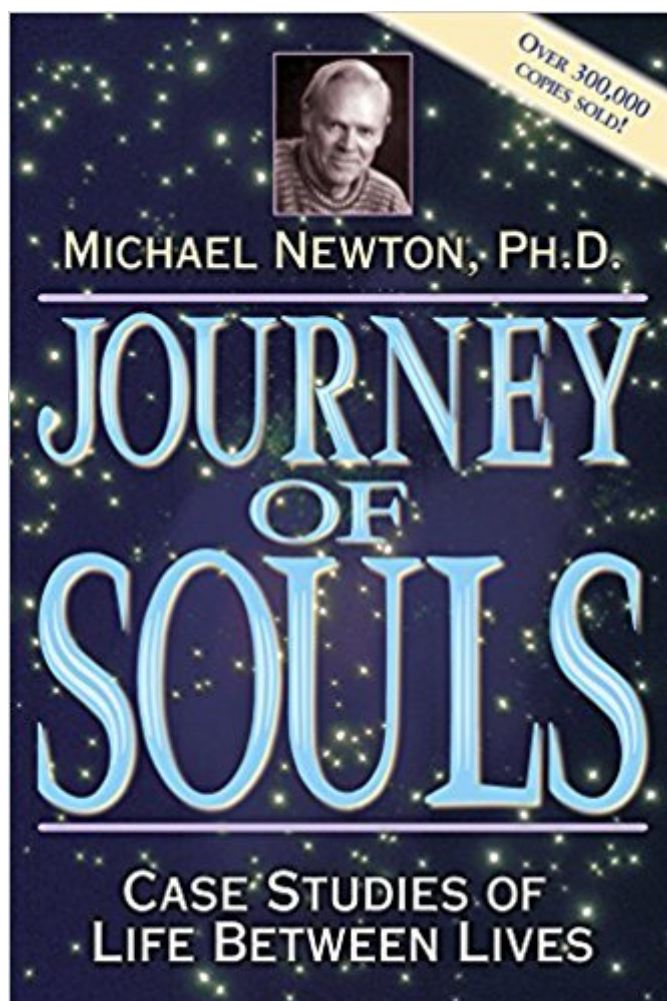

I so badly want to know that he's still with me now in some way, that I'll see him again, so I'm trying to educate & convince myself... In my desperate attempts to FIND a true belief in Spirit I've purchased many books. I've read the first 1/2 of most of them, then I tire. Then I came across this beautiful book, this gift, that has truly given me hope, made sense of things that I'd not been open to before. I'm a left-brain, scientific, fact-based thinker and the people who claim to know, really know about a God or an existence beyond, well, they've not been people that I could relate to... Now I'm truly getting there thanks to Journey of Souls. Would it sound too crazy if I called it one of the most meaningful, hopeful, beautiful book I've ever read? My paperback copy is on my nightstand for constant go-to when I have a crashing wave of pain, I have it on Audible to lull me to sleep when I can't otherwise, and I've purchased 12 other copies for friends and family. I LOVE this book and am so thankful for its gifts to me.

I have a very analytical mind and always have a tendency to ask questions in any kind of situation(s). Growing up, I have been exposed to different religions and I have come to the conclusion that at the very foundation, all religions are the same - try to be a good person and not harm others. Problems start with religion when we introduce intermediaries - like priests - and become even more complex and politics is in the mix. I consider religion a way of controlling society because many of us will not question an instruction from a higher authority who says - "you will not enter heaven, if you perform such an action". This book has impacted my life in the most profound manner. I cannot even comprehend how much it is. Even if the contents are not true, it does not matter. I know that after reading this book, I have been able to change the way I live my life, the way I have empathy for others, my true purpose in life and lastly but not the least - having peace and not afraid of death, whether it is my own or my immediate family. The only thing you have to keep in mind is - be open to what the book is talking about. And ask your heart rather than your mind (there is a big difference) what you feel. You will be pleasantly surprised. I highly recommend this book for personal growth and development.

This book is the compilation of case histories by a hypnotist who regresses his clients to the time they spend between lifetimes in a sort of afterlife or heaven. It's fascinating reading and potentially

life changing for the reader in terms of beginning to understand those in his or her life who have brought love or challenges...all of which may have been predetermined. Great concepts to wonder about!!

Each case study dialogue is suspiciously uniform and mostly unchanging in style and diction from one to another. A lack of use of contractions also makes the "dialogue" appear less authentic. The author makes no note of taking any literary liberty with the sessions which he states have been recorded. Others on this comment board claim to have had personal experiences with the author. Even so, the fault of suspicion rests with the author and his approach. An independent verification by outside therapists, along with having several of these cases come forward, with the original recordings made available for those same cases, would go a long way in restoring a sense of credibility to all of these stories.

This is a fascinating book but not one I'd call a "good" or "easy" read. Our soul growth is, by these accounts, slow and complex and so learning about it a bit overwhelming and a big leap from the memory accounts of previous lifetimes found in most books on reincarnation. I'd highly recommend it if you're up for in depth learnings about the soul state between lives...just be prepared for perhaps "more than you ever wanted to know." I do have a complaint that the author dismisses the bible and Jesus by simple omission of their mention in the book. I am not a religious person, not a church goer. But Christianity, by being so woven into our culture, deserves some discussion in a book such as this: Does Dr. Newton ever ask about Jesus or the Bible in his hypnosis questioning? If so or if not we don't get any discussion here! For that matter, similar omission is noted for other religions/religious leaders as well.

I don't know if I believe a word that Newton is saying but, at the very least, it's a creative book and it sparks the imagination. It challenges some of my traditional Christian beliefs but that's okay. It's a big universe and I like having my cage rattled. In other ways, it's very familiar in that we all have to work through our shortcomings, in order to grow, and that Our Source loves us. Having also greatly admired my Buddhist teacher, Michio Kushi, I can see how a lot of this book also harmonizes very well with his point of view. The necessity for some to return here, or to continue their learning on other planets, or the freedom of some to return Home, to dwell in Unity, only to spring out again at some future or past place/time, on yet another adventure. I find that I kinda skim through Newton's explanations because I'm anxious to get on to the next soul interview.

Anyone whos been asking those main qtns about life, your purpose etc - read this. Will help you get some peace of mind and desire to learn more!
