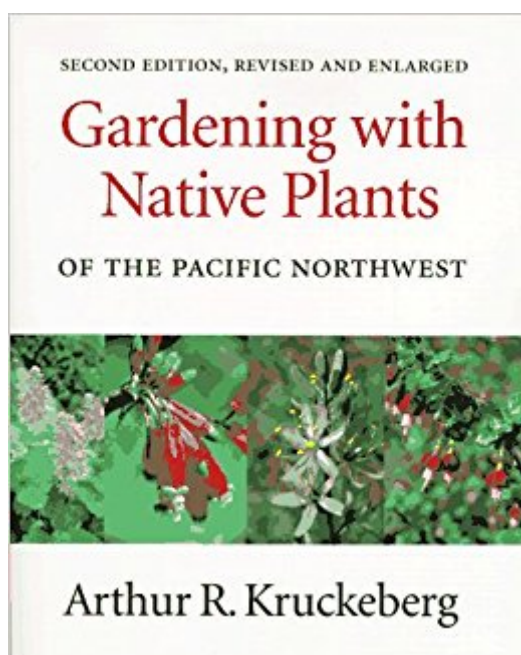

This is a very comprehensive book about native plants of the Northwest. It's well written and I have found it very helpful.

This book definitely falls in the category of an oldie, but a goodie. First published in 1982, it describes a wide selection of native plants appropriate for gardens ranging from Northern California to Southern British Columbia. The plants are divided into categories (trees, shrubs, herbaceous perennials), and photos are provided. Additional information is provided on naming, sourcing, and propagating native plants. Gardening with Native Plants of the Pacific Northwest should be on the bookshelf of gardeners, outdoor enthusiasts, and conservationists.

The book is complete with specific advice for each plant. This book would be outstanding with color photos. This is a good reference book.
