

The number of annual suicides in the United States is double that of the number of homicides. For every completed suicide, there are approximately six survivors. This means roughly 240,00 suicide loss survivors were created in the United States just this year.

This book contains some valuable phone numbers and information in the last chapter that could save the life of someone you care about or are acquainted with.

I learned a lot by reading this book. I can't say I enjoyed reading the book although it is very well written. All of the stories in the book are very sad and even depressing to read. This book was a very eye opening experience and it certainly makes the reader think about suicide - the why and the how. The thing that really touched me was the way suicide affects the lives of those left behind.

Some of the contributors wrote about a suicide that happened twenty or thirty years ago. Their lives are still impacted by the loss of a loved one in such a tragic way.
