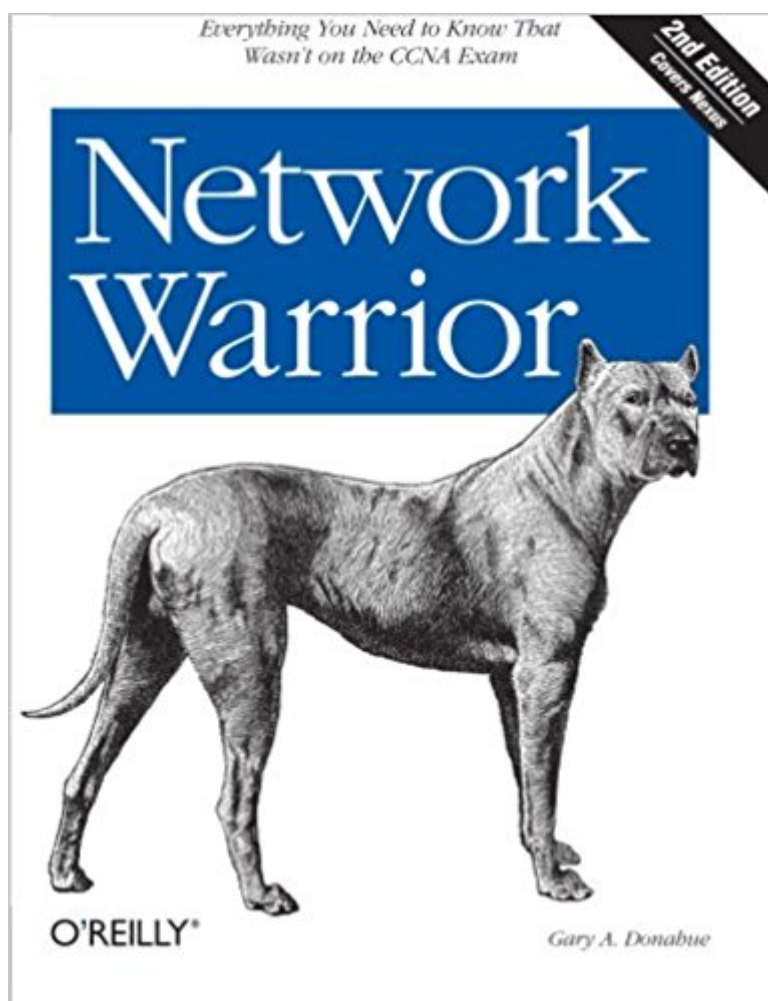

Whether you're showing up on the job fresh from a Cisco certification with no job experience or you've been in the field for awhile this book has something to offer that you're not going to find elsewhere. In a nutshell, it is the networking book to help you get your job done. The book focuses on teaching what you need to know on the job and not just information to pass a certification exam. It helps turn on light bulbs that you may not get when reading Cisco Press books. It explains things with simple examples and uses fun analogies. I have to say this is the first networking book that I have read that I just didn't want to put down. (think spy thriller or mystery novel) If you are in the networking field, buy this book and read it cover to cover like I did. (or virtual cover to cover via Kindle in my case) Absolutely wonderful book!

This book gives so much insight. The content is so easy to read and rarely feel bored. Good strong foundation with plenty examples of troubleshooting.

We have a lot of Cisco kit and sometimes you just really need a solid explanation without the BS Cisco documentation or 'no-speaky-english' posts you get from a Google smash. The author is both experienced enough to give excellent advice and a great communicator. Not really a good book for beginners, but perfect for intermediate Network and Sysadmins who need to understand various Network technologies.

Working in the I.T. field as a network admin I've read plenty of books and manuals over the years dealing with networking, most were dry and not really relevant to what I work on day to day. Network Warrior fills that gap providing a mix of the author's real-world experiences with us (IT Professionals) are most likely to be working with. I would definitely recommend this book, the writing style is easy to read and holds my interest. I'll be looking for more from this author.

When you go to a network forum, and post about asking for books, there is a reason why Network Warrior is in 90% of the answers. The book assumes you have a basic knowledge of networking and builds up from there. It covers how to do things in a variety of networks (Cisco Cat OS, iOS, NX-OS) and give you some of the other terminology as well. This is a great book to continue your

education as a network engineer, and it is a great reference as well.

GAD has a way with engaging his audience. I enjoyed this book thoroughly . It is my go to book whenever I need a quick read/refresh of network implementation.
