

She accidentally ends up in Mexico with Stone and gets mixed up in one of Stoneâ ÂTMs assignments. She learns more

about Stone, but many questions linger on. The 8th book of the Rachael Oâ Â™Brien Chronicles, Hot Tamale, has a great, exciting storyline. The problem with it is that it is in bad need of an additional editing run-through. At least once I noticed the wrong characterâ Â™s name is used and many times a random word would appear in a sentence when it shouldnâ Â™t have. One time I couldnâ Â™t figure out what the sentence was supposed to say. Without those editing issues, it would have been a 5 star book.

OMG, as usual, this book leaves you wanting more! The end came too soon! I wasn't ready! In true Rachel fashion, she finds herself in more trouble than she asked for or can handle, but not to worry, her friends are always there to help her out .. including her ex-boyfriend who may or may not be a spy.. this book will take you on a journey from beginning to end and is fun until the very last page.
