Horticulturist la Croix selected the fraction of orchid species that may be cultivated in gardens and greenhouses to summarize for enthusiasts and interested readers. Chapters briefly discussing the basics of cultivation, pests and diseases, and conservation are followed by an Aâ "Z of genera and species. Each of the 350 genera that are included is described, with worldwide distribution and general cultivation requirements given. Entries for each species

include plant and blossom size and characteristics as well as native location and habitat conditions. A substantial number of the species entries are accompanied by large, attractive photographs. The volume also contains a glossary, a bibliography, and common and scientific name indexes. This is a great reference material & well illuminated, except it is not exhaustive in culture (like temperature, media for potting, water frequecy & etc.), it has only briefly indicated the species' habitat and altitude. For a novice like me, would need to do extra work on googling geographically to understand species habitat's culture. It would be best if author could add more pictures of the species in their natural habitat.Shipping : Very fast delivery in good conditions.Condition of the book : I paid U\$55 (incl shipping cost to Singapore) for a new book,

but the hardcover on page 2 was split with the book content upon received yesterday (on 09 Jun 2015). I have to glue them back altogether, quite disappointing with the published quality. This is a wonderful picture book of orchid around the world with descriptions of each plant and growth requirements for each. it would be a good book for beginner orchid growers and advanced growers alike.

I am pleased to share my passion about the orchids and reading this great encyclopedia. There are lots of beautiful pictures and useful information. Dr. Isoybal la Croix is a prominent botanist especially in orchids, so I have learnt a lot from her book. I live in Taiwan, a beautiful subtropical island called Formosa, which means beauty and there are some of the most beautiful species have their scientific names such as Cypripedium formosanum, Dendrobium formosum (not native to Taiwan), Phalaenopsis aphrodite v. formosana, and Pleione formosana. I am lucky to grow my orchids at the balcony of my house naturally without any greenhouse equipment. However, I found a little error in the book, on pp.86 the description of Cattleya, the second paragraph writings:..... They(Cattleyas) have been widely used in hybridization, both itrageneric and intergeneric with related genera such as "Brassia", Laeliea, Rhycholaeliea, and Sophronitis. I confirm that it should be "Broassovola" rather than "Brassia" which cannot cross with Cattleya alliance. In addition, the photograph of Sophronitis tenebrosa on pp.440, I can tell it is Soph. grandis and these two species

are very similar. I love this picture because it is the most beautiful Cattelyode orchid I've ever seen!!

An encyclopedia, no care information. Beautiful book.

I must admit that at first before I ordered this book, I had installed Orchid Wiz on my computer, and thought I would not purchase any more books on orchids, but on seeing this book for sale, I would have to say I weakened. And as it turns out , I am glad I did.What a truly magnificent publication. It's well above my expectations and a real treasure to have in my quite extensive library.The photographs would be the best I have seen in any of my 30 plus books,(I didn't realize I had so many.)and the text matches the prints.
