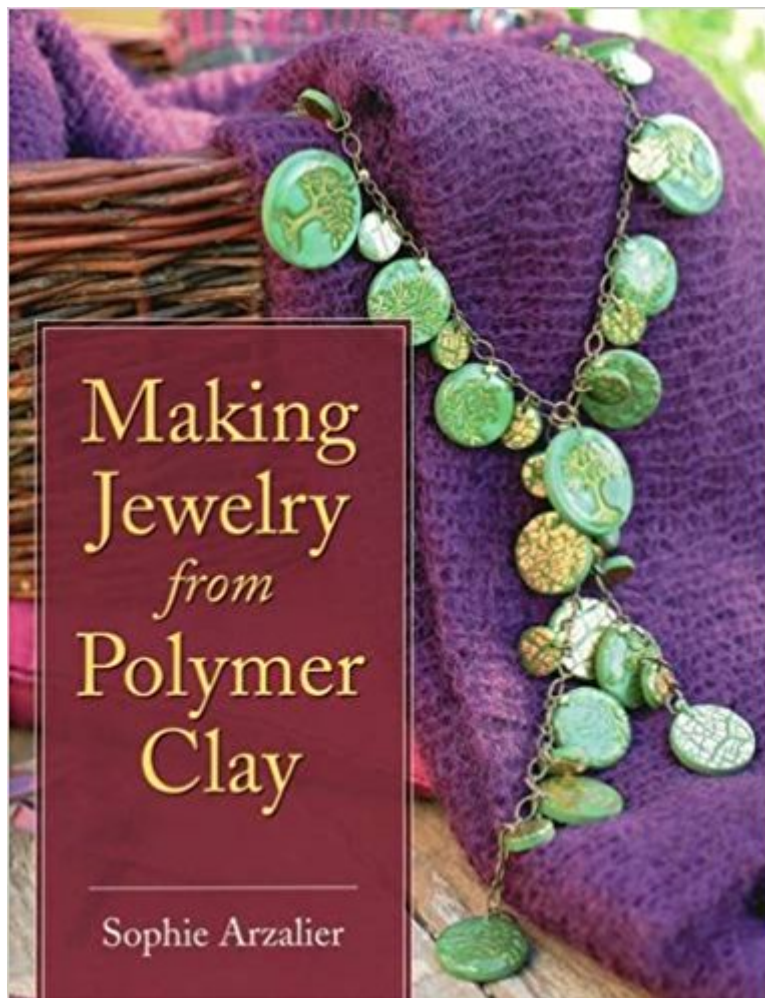

This book gives you projects to work on that are gorgeous and very easy to understand.
