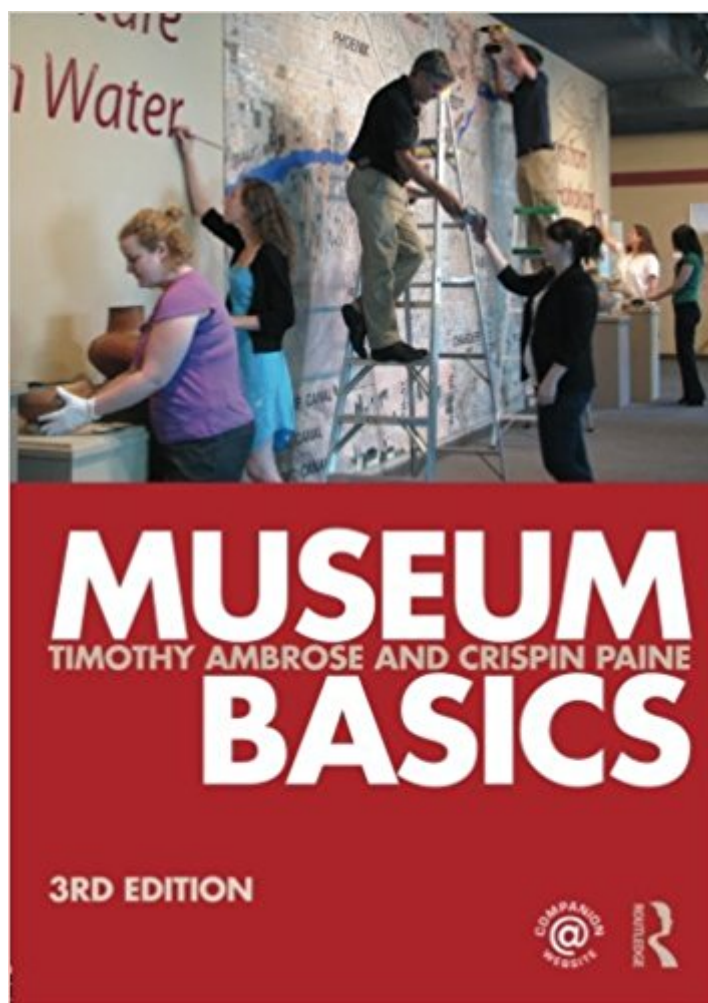

Unlike many museum theory textbooks, this is clearly and straightforwardly written, with an international scope. An instantly comprehensible primer, with lists of cross-referencing between related units of information. The only cons are - As a guide of what to do, it doesn't acknowledge that it is a perfect-world simulation, and that real small to medium museums cannot possibly live up to every guideline. Also, the book is a little repetitive. Great if you are cherry-picking certain topics and sections, but a bit much if you are reading cover to cover.
