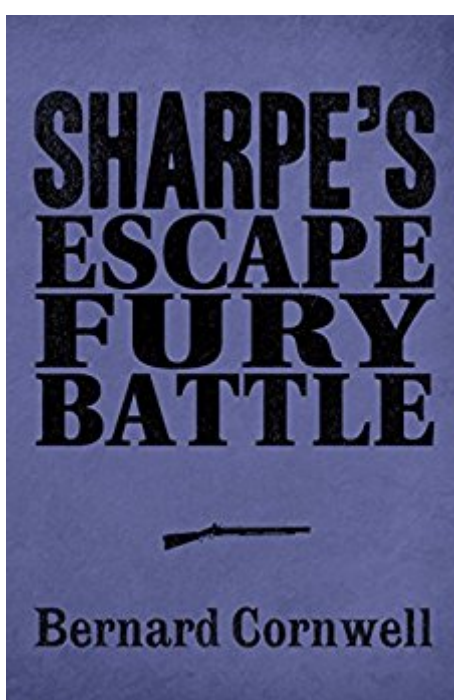

Cornwell's writing remains highly descriptive and easy to read. It contains graphic descriptions of mutilation and severe wounding and gallons of blood and guts - dead and dying everywhere. This becomes somewhat tiresome after many pages and I found myself wondering if the descriptions

were being used to pad the content and I tended to become lost in his explanations of some of the military manoeuvres. Nevertheless, an entertaining read which held my attention throughout, even if the books are not as gripping as Cornwell's earlier efforts.

If they were not such good yarns, Sharpe novels would be excellent examples of "soft" History of the Peninsular War. But History takes a back seat because we are there with Sharpe and the lads, fighting properly hatable adversaries who being evil meet their deserving end at the end having troubled greatly our Hero. The smell of black powder is there and the cries and the swords and the wicked wounds with blood and gore and Glory. Sharpe triumphs again over adversity and injustice and we expect a hefty dose of the same in the next book. Beware it is addictive. D.V. Kokkinos
