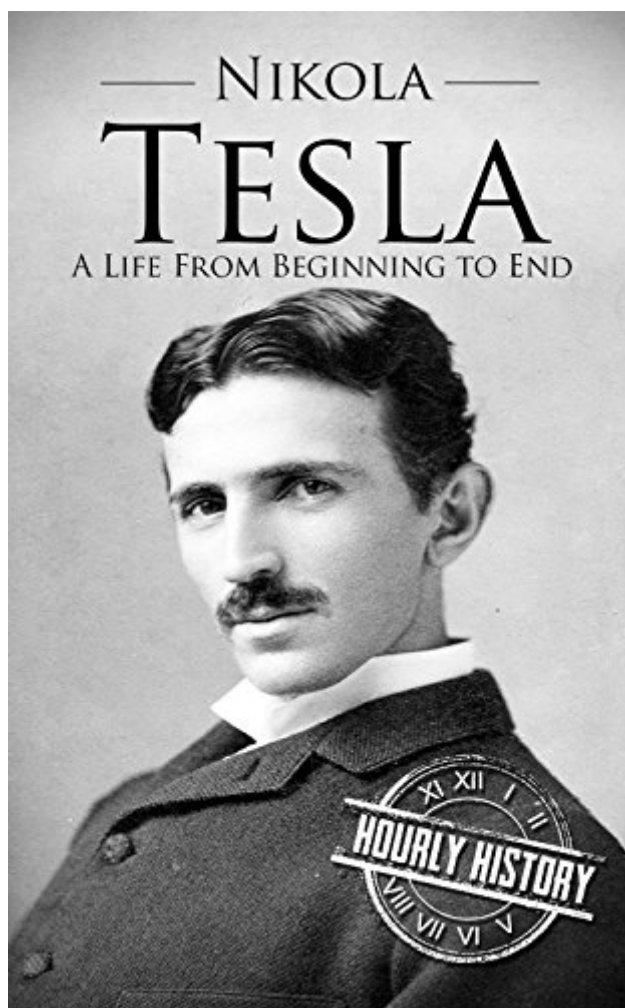

This is not a book. It is very short, more like an term paper. It is about 50 pages long with large type and spacing. Some "chapters are 1.5 pages. It took all of about 30 to 45 minutes to read it so don't buy this if you are expecting a real book. A very easy read, but over-priced for what you get. there isn't even a publisher page other than saying it was copy write protected in 2017.
